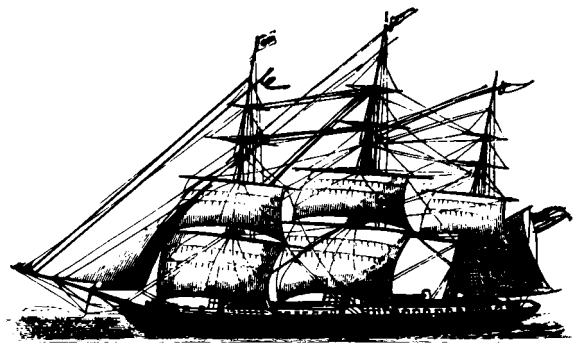

“GRAND KNIGHTS NOTES”

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS ULTRASOUND PROJECT
Lima Knights of Columbus Council #2661 in cooperation with surrounding K of C Councils from **Columbus Grove, Kalida, Lima, Ottawa, Ottoville, Bluffton** and **Van Wert** have joined together in an Ultrasound Initiative. Our seven (8) Councils will begin an Ultrasound fund raising campaign at all Masses beginning the first weekend of June to raise sufficient funds to purchase an Ultrasound machine for **HEARTBEAT OF LIMA**. **HEARTBEAT** is one of several leading groups in our local area leading in the struggle and fight against abortion. Data from the Supreme Knights of Columbus Council indicate that up to 90% of women considering abortion choose to have their baby after seeing an Ultrasound image. They hear their baby’s heartbeat; they see their baby’s head and fingers. They know it is a child, not a “choice.”

As most of you already know, an abortion facility named Capital Care Network based out of Columbus has located at 222 S. Elizabeth St. in Lima. **HEARTBEAT OF LIMA** was fortunate in that with the help of several generous donors they have been in a position to open their Satellite Office right next door at 226 S. Elizabeth St. This is where the new Ultrasound machine will be located. **HEARTBEAT OF LIMA** already offers excellent life counseling services for those with unwanted/crisis pregnancies, various infant/child parenting programs, infant nurturing instructions, provides certain equipment such as car seats, bassinets, etc. They already have an excellent reputation as “a place to go” for help.

The Ultrasound Initiative promoted by the Knights of Columbus is headed into its third year of existence. In the initiative the Supreme Council of the Knights of Columbus provides a matching grant for every state or local council that raises half the cost to purchase Ultrasound equipment for medically certified pro-life pregnancy centers. **HEARTBEAT OF LIMA** meets all the criteria to qualify for the matching grant from the Supreme Council as well as required medical certifications.

The Ultrasound equipment retail price runs in the \$50,000.00 plus range. Our group of Councils has been able to negotiate a discount of about 50% for a new, quality piece of equipment which means our cost will be around \$25,000.00. If our group of K of C Councils can raise around \$13,000.00 we will be eligible to receive the matching grant from our Supreme Council. There will be additional expenses such as the cost of malpractice insurance, training and certification for the staff, equipment maintenance, etc. Any funds raised over and above equipment cost will be applied to those expenses.

We ask that you pray that our Councils will be successful in this extremely important pro-life program. And we ask that please be generous with your contribution. “WE STAND STRONG ON ETHICAL GROUND”

Some people believe that ethics in business is a contradiction in terms. They think that in order to be profitable, a company and its leaders must abandon morality and embrace the dark, greedy side of capitalism. At the Knights of Columbus, we know this business model is incorrect. As a Catholic organization, we understand the value and importance of our core beliefs and the original mission of Father Michael J. McGivney. In fact, much of the strength and financial security we provide to members and their families can be attributed to our ethical, moral standards. These standards are visible throughout the Order, from our fraternal programs and support of the Church and its teaching to the investment strategy of our assets.

"What sets us apart is what Standard & Poor's refers to as the 'very conservative' approach we take in managing our \$16 billion in assets," said Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson in his 2010 address at the Supreme Convention. "We place 'a very high value on the society's reputation'." This means carefully planning when it comes time to invest. Our professional staff researches all transactions to insure that they fall in line with Catholic values. If a transaction makes them uncomfortable, they don't make it.

"We exclude any company engaged in activity that conflicts with Catholic moral teaching: companies directly involved in abortion, contraception, human cloning, embryonic stem cell research, for-profit health care that pays for any of these, or pornography," said the Supreme Knight. "There are many companies in the pharmaceutical and communications industries that would undoubtedly provide excellent returns for us, but which are not in our portfolio because they engage in research and development or programming in ways that violate the sanctity or dignity of human life."

In the end, the Knights of Columbus investment strategy is motivated by morality and not money-making. Yet, each year we remain profitable, increase our assets and stay dedicated to this vision that will keep the Order sound financially for generations to come

"Faithful Catholics have choices when buying life insurance," said the Supreme Knight. "But they know that at the Knights of Columbus their policy is supplied by an insurer that shares their moral and ethical values and is guided in all of its investment and sales practices by those values."
